Monday, May 10, 2021

Mayor Rysavy called the meeting to order.

Auditor Report: Delinquent water bills discussed. Residents will be notified of shut off day May 21, 2021 @ 1 p.m. The Auditor will be out of the office from 5/12/2021 until 5/21/2021 for training in Bismarck.

Ordinance #112 violation were discussed. The residents in violation have been notified. Council members have been in contact with citizens and progress is being made.

Sidewalk repairs. Scott Gilbertson presented a rough estimate to the Council for replacing sidewalks around the Mall area. There will be a notice in the paper for bidding the concrete work for the City. Funds will be allocated for the project.

Street Sweeping. Streets sweeping will be scheduled by Scott Gilbertson for some time in June. Residents will be notified.

Children operating golf carts. There have been multiple complaints to the Mayor and Council about children operating golf carts in town. The Council is genuinely concerned for the safety of the children and expects parents to take necessary precautions that will ensure the safety of their children. The City has no way to enforce transportation violations. Anyone witnessing children operating a golf cart unsafely or in an unsafe area needs to contact the parents of the child or call the Nelson County Sheriff.
